Laboratory Assistant

OVERALL PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

- To provide expert technical support to teachers and students in Science, Agriculture and STEAM.
- Work cooperatively within the laboratory team in the preparation of equipment requirements for classes and ensure necessary documentation is maintained.
- Work with the laboratory team in reviewing and managing laboratory safety standards and procedures, communicating these standards to all staff as applicable.
- Ensure that appropriate standards of work, health and safety are incorporated into the work undertaken; taking steps to ensure the health, safety and well-being of self and others in the workplace; support the School's Wellbeing programs.

PRIMARY DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- To work as part of a team to provide expert technical support to teachers and students in Science, Agriculture and STEAM, reporting directly to the Head of Science and under the direction of the lead laboratory staff.
 - Ensure that teachers have appropriate laboratory equipment and resources for the conduct of their teaching programs, assessments, excursions, competitions, practical examinations and special events.
 - o Ensure that all equipment is well maintained and in working order.
 - Assist in sourcing equipment, chemicals, live specimens and any other resources needed for teaching of the Science curriculum.
 - Advise teachers of any issues regarding equipment that would limit the success of their lessons and endeavour to correct the issue as soon as possible.
 - To ensure all chemicals and equipment are properly stocked, maintained, and meet safety regulations
 - o Ensure records are maintained and secured
- Assist, seek, and share information and communicate with all members of the team.
- To maintain appropriate professional development through identifying new skills and training.
- To attend regular departmental and team meetings.

The laboratory team report directly to the Head of Science and the daily responsibilities are organised by the laboratory workflow leader.

- Tertiary qualifications Science Degree or Science Technician Certificate.
- Experience in working in a science laboratory setting, with preferable experience also in a school setting.
- Physical capability for lifting, carrying and moving equipment across 25 laboratories and 3 buildings.

- Innovative problem solver, with initiative and resourcefulness who can undertake tasks with minimal supervision. Tasks include preparation of laboratory work and general support of the teaching staff.
- Exceptional personal standards of honesty, integrity and professionalism.
- Team player willing to foster a strong service culture.
- Commitment to the School's Mission, Vision and Values.
- Ability to support the Christian values and ethos of the School
