COVID-19 SPORTS FIXTURES PROTOCOLS
as of Saturday 24th April

The following protocols have been put in place to ensure the safety of all players, staff, parents and supporters attending school sports at Saint Ignatius College, Riverview and comply with NSW Health Guidelines revised April, 2021.

Please do not attend any fixture at Saint Ignatius' College if you:

- Have any of the following COVID 19 symptoms - Coughing, fever, sore throat, loss of taste and running nose.

SPECTATORS

We welcome spectators at all of our sporting venues.

- All spectators and coaches are required to sign in using the Service NSW COVID Safe QR Codes provided at the school. Please have the check-in screen available shall a Covid marshall ask to see it.
- Parents can park or drop off students at the front of the campus and walk to the venue.

PLAYERS

- Arrive dressed & ready to play - change rooms will be available but should be used sparingly.
- Encouraged to bring own hand sanitizer
- Shower at home before & after the game
- Bring own water bottle clearly labelled
- Bring own towel
- Do not share personal items (uniforms, drink bottles, towels, etc)

COACHES

- Ensure an accurate attendance register is taken for the COVID-19 Safety tracking if required.

FOOD, DRINKS AND AMENITIES

- There will be no after match functions for players and parents during Trial games.
- Canteens, food stores and barbeques will be open on campus.
- Bubblers are not operational.
- Bathrooms will be open and will be professionally cleaned on a regular basis.

Staff will be in place to ensure spectators comply with these rules to ensure the safety of the Riverview and opposition school community.
