

The following protocols have been put in place to ensure the safety of all players, staff and spectators attending school sport at Barker.

Pre-Attendance Agreement

Please do not attend Barker Sport fixtures as either a player, staff member or spectator if you:

- feel unwell or exhibit flu-like symptoms
- have been in contact with a known or suspected case of COVID – 19
- are at a high health risk – including the elderly and those with pre-existing conditions
- reside with clinically vulnerable individuals
- have recently visited various locations of identified COVID – 19 clusters

Entry Points

Access will be restricted to the following entry points located on the college map (attached):

- Rosewood Centre Carpark (Unwin Rd)
- Rosewood Field Pedestrian Gate (Unwin Rd)
- Gamson Centre Pedestrian Gate (College Crescent) GATE 3
- Junior School Gate (Clarke Road)
- Tennis Court Carpark (Clarke Rd)

Registration

- Upon entry, all players, staff and spectators will be required to register using the Services NSW QR Code
- Hard copy registration will be available for those who do not have a mobile device

Facilities

- A canteen will be in operation on level 3 in the Rosewood Centre
- Toilets will be available and clearly marked. Please ensure good hygiene practices are adhered to
- Changerooms will be available for players only to 'get in/get out'. Please do not meet or congregate inside.
- Water bubblers will be operational for filling of water bottles. Please, no drinking directly from the bubblers
- Cleaning of facilities will be ongoing during the day
- First aid will be available on Rosewood Fields and Rosewood Centre
- Barker has a NO DOG policy

Player Information

Players are asked to:

- Arrive in playing uniform where possible to reduce time spent in changerooms
- Bring and use their own sanitiser
- Bring and use their own clearly marked drink bottle, which is not to be shared
- Bring their own food where possible
